## BadgerCare Plus

BadgerCare Plus is a health care program designed to help low-income children, pregnant members, and adults in Wisconsin.



## Medicaid SSI

Medicaid Supplemental Security Income (SSI) is a health services program for people with physical, developmental, or emotional disabilities.



## BadgerCare Plus

BadgerCare Plus is a Medicaid program that provides health care services to low-income adults and children in Wisconsin.

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE

*(Must live in covered service area)*

- 18 years or younger with income at or below 300% of the federal poverty level (FPL).
- A parent or caretaker of a child age 18 or younger with income at or below 100% FPL.
- 19 through 64 years old, not receiving Medicare, no dependent children, and an income at or below 100% FPL.
- A pregnant person with income at or below 300% of the FPL.

Supplemental Security Income (SSI)-Related Medicaid provides health care coverage for adults 65 and older and people with disabilities.

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE

*(Must live in covered service area)*

- Low income
- 65 years or older and low income
- Blind or disabled according to the Disability Determination Bureau
